Strategic Priorities:

Increase accountability to CfLI's core values of inclusive collaboration and socio-cultural awareness.

Context:

- CfLI survey indicated that some of our stakeholders who identified as racial minorities stated that their experience of CfLI services did not meet their expectations.
- Because CfLI strives to serve all students (primarily undergraduate students), CfLI is positioned to positively influence understanding of power and privilege structures related to campus climate.

Increase recognition of CfLI's name in connection to its programs and services.

Context:

- To more fully communicate to the entire university community of students, faculty and staff, the center's mission and value throughout the year

Improve the accessibility of CfLI resources.

Context:

- Based on CfLI User survey results, stakeholders indicated that the availability and ease of use of CfLI information should be improved.

Clarify resources and support for graduate/professional students.

Context:

- CfLI User survey indicated confusion about how CfLI serves graduate /professional students
